

OBJECTIVES OF THE CONFERENCE

- Innovations in engineering and technology for organic and agroecological production, harvesting, weed management, mulching, processing and related areas.

2) Marketing:


- Approaches to market development, quality control, including participatory guarantee systems (PGS) and third-party certification.
- Impact of marketing tools/ pathways on business growth and economic advancement of the organic sector.

3) Education, training and capacity building

- Studies on educational methods, curriculum development
- Capacity building for organic agriculture and agroecology at all levels.
- True-cost accounting and ecosystem services

4) Cross-cutting issues:

- Engagement of women, youths and vulnerable groups in organic and agroecological farming.
- Global warming, climate change and environmental conservation
- Policy analyses, extension approaches, and farmer-led research results that support the scaling up and institutionalization of organic and agroecological practices in Africa.



- Only those duly registered for the conference shall be allowed to present papers or posters during the event.




